Local drunken teen kills girlfriend

Las Vegas Nev., May 2012: "I shot her because she wouldn't stop moaning." Those were the words of 19-year-old Ricardo Perez from Henderson as he turned himself in at the Clark County jail and told police he shot a female friend twice before dumping her body in the desert.

Police say in an arrest report that 18-year-old Breanna Lynn Carasik-McGee's body was found where Perez said it would be.

Perez was transferred to jail on Tuesday pending an initial court appearance after telling detectives he wanted to take responsibility for his actions.

He tells police he shot Carasik-McGee in the head with a 9 mm handhol at a friend's trailer east of downtown Las Vegas.

Police say Perez told detectives he drove Carasik-McGee into the desert south of College Drive in Henderson, shot her again

gun after both drank alco- in the head because she was still alive and left the body. The arrest report says he told police that he was drink-

ing heavily and had consumed more than two dozen beers at a friend's house. Perez had his mother's

gun and was playing with it. That's when he pulled the trigger, shooting Carasik-McGee in the head. When asked why he didn't take her to the hospital, Perez says he panicked and thought she would die anyway.

Marijuana drug war kills thousands

The drug war kills thousands more people than drugs have ever killed. Our 25,000 gangs now kill more than 10,000 Americans yearly and our drug war also causes about 10,000 Mexican murders yearly.

Thousands more drug war deaths occur in prison where one third of prisoners are dead by age 45.

Marijuana is the safest recreational, over-the-counter or prescription drug in history. You absolutely cannot die from it, but gangs, prison, the DEA or cops can kill you, as they did a guy in Las Vegas last year. The teenage murder rate is 19 times higher than in the

Netherlands where drugs have been taxed and controlled for 37 years. Nineteen times more drug war deaths and many are just teernagers! And these are predominantly minority murders or this horrendous war would have been over decades ago.

Drug overdose rate is 20 to 40 times higher than the Netherlands depending on which American city is compared. The reason for this is that in Holland, they are buying drugs that are pure, sterile, and in known milligrams, not bathtub street drugs.

In addition, if someone does crash, they are not afraid to call 911 as they know they will not be arrested for being around drugs. Result? Still more un-"Drugs" continued on page 2

The next item on the agenda was the motion to accept the 2012 platform as submitted, and the motion carried without the floor fight that was anticipated. Love, Marriage and Money: Understanding how marriage and debt walk down the aisle together

Summer is getting closer, and summer is the official wedding season. Sure, more people actually get married on Valentines Day or on New Years Eve, but the wedding season is June and July. August not so much.

Weddings are about love, and love and marriage go together like, well, you know. And while the cost of a wedding can break the bank, what about afterwards?

While most people know that Nevada is a community property state, besides believing "what's yours is mine, and mine is yours," few people understand the laws about marriage, money and debts. Ouch! What a romantic-moodkilling thought!

Even so, when the bad things happen, as eventually they will, it helps to understand how marriage and debt walk down the wedding aisle.

First, the good news. Community property does not require you to be responsible for any of your partner's debts before you were married. Marriage does not make you

legally responsible for most kinds of debts your spouse makes during the marriage in his or her own name alone. Creditors cannot sue you to force you to pay your spouse's student loans, credit card debts, car loans or other debts in his or her

name alone. In addition, if your spouse has bad credit. the bad credit usually will not affect your credit unless you foolishly apply for credit together. Applying for credit together may cause the bad credit information from your spouse's account to merge onto your credit and damage your credit score. Although there are ways to repair this damage, it can be a time-consuming and frustrating process that

should be avoided by not taking the unnecessary risk of applying for joint credit.

However, with the good news comes the bad news. If a creditor obtains a court judgment against your spouse, any joint assets, such as bank accounts, real estate, or other property purchased together can be seized by law enforcement to pay the judgment of the other spouse. If you put property into joint names, be very careful if your spouse has unpaid debts because your income, your savings, and your property can be taken to pay your spouse's court judgment if your spouse's name is on the title. The reason why your spouse's name is on the title to your property is unimportant. If your spouse (or any one else's) name is on the title, he or she is considered to be a

co-owner of the property. A creditor can act to take all co-owned property even if you were not responsible for the debt.

I was fairly familiar with Harry Belafonte's life and career before reading this book, but I had no idea of the depth and the scope that it covered both in his musical and acting career and especially in his connection to the civil

At every opportunity, he would go to the jazz clubs in New York. He got to meet many of the jazzmen, who took a liking to him, and a turning point came when, at the Royal Roost, Lester Young, the great jazz tenor sax man

When he was discharged, he studied acting under the GI bill, attending the Dramatic Workshop of the New School in N.Y. Some of his classmates at that time were Marlon Brando, Sidney Portier, Tony Curtis, Walter Mat-

He started into showbiz by studying and wanting to be an actor, but after being pushed into singing, finding his natural niche with calypso, and seeing the reaction of the audiences and the returns at the box offices, Belafonte had arrived at stardom. From that point, partly because of his talent, incredibly good looks, and rapport with people,



the main thrust of his story turns to the civil rights movement, and his meeting Martin Luther King.

For me, the most important and interesting part of the book starts with his commitment and work for the civil

rights movement, which he could not have accomplished without the tremendous financial income generated from his entertainment efforts.

During his many years of working with Dr. King, he

became a great friend and confidante. Together they planned dates and conditions for the marches and gatherings, which included Birmingham, Montgomery, Selma, and Washington.

Belafonte saw early on what a difference his celebrity status made financially, and as help in drawing people in to help the cause. With this in mind, he set up many fund-raisers and called on top entertainers to perform: People like Frank Sinatra, Marlon Brando, Henry Fonda, Paul Newman, Tony Bennett, Lena Horne, Burt Lancaster, Tony Curtis, and many others. According to Belafonte, they were always there for him and for the movement.

Belafonte became a conduit from Dr. King to the Kennedy administration, talking to JFK, and Robert Kennedy, who was then the Attorney General. They didn't always agree on the direction the administration would take on a particular issue, and the dialogue between them was fascinating. I found the political exchanges to be the most intriguing parts of the book. Here are a couple of examples:

"The Kennedy clan hadn't reached out to me because they liked the way I sang. Wherever they looked in the civil rights movement, I had already made it my business to be there, and not just as a celebrity lending his name."

"Through Eleanor Roosevelt, I'd met leading figures in several of the newly-or soon to be independent African nations."

During a Dr. King jailing: "This ain't no game," I told Bobby. "It's the real thing. Maybe it's time you open your copy of Gandhi."

"Bobby," I said, "I appreciate the position you're in, but you are not going to stop us, so you better start getting used to the fact that it's not going to happen, and start trying to help us make it work."

If you remember the "We Are The World" video, Belafonte headed the effort to complete that project which raised millions of dollars to fight hunger in Ethiopia and the Sudan.

Belafonte always disagreed with Bush going into Iraq, and asks to this day "Who was right?" Unfortunately, because of space, there is so much I am leaving out. I found it to be fascinating read. I'm sure you will too.

cover protection for his family when his career ends, and while that is very important, I think that what is most important is that he be there with them and in a healthy state. In an interview recently, Bart said, "I don't want my son (seven years old,) to play football. I play football so he won't have to. With what is going on, I don't know if it is really worth it." About two percent of the players who play in college make it to the National Football League. "What about the other 98 percent," Scott said.
