Obama speaks to UNLV students

On June 7, 2012, an impressive crowd gathered to hear President Barrack Obama speak at the Cox Pavilion on a sunny summer afternoon. Free tickets were distributed from the Cox Pavilion's box office in the days leading up to the speech. The excitement was palpable from the line leading to the security checkpoint. Just half an hour

after the doors first opened, the room was a packed.

A grand American flag served as the backdrop for the inspiring scene. All the people there, young and old, students and veterans, Republicans and Democrats, were there to listen to the Commander in Chief speak. Video cameras were set up on elevated platforms, and volunteers were bustling about to get everyone seated. There was never a ceasing

of the spectators' movements. The standing floor was flooded with camera-wielding citizens waiting to catch a photo of their president. The crowd stood for the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance and a stirring performance of the National Anthem. Facebook may allow kids under 13 to join By Nisean Lorde

Millions of kids worldwide may soon be able to join the world's number one social networking site - without having to lie about their ages. Facebook is looking to expand its vast social network by allowing kids under the age of 13 to join.

In a statement, Facebook noted that "many recent reports have highlighted just how difficult it is to enforce age restrictions on the Internet, especially when parents want their children to access online content and services."

A few of the options the company is looking at include connecting children's accounts to their parents' and giving parents control over whom their kids can friend and what ap-

Although Facebook's terms of service currently require users to be at least 13 years old (federal law requires companies to obtain parental consent if they want to collect information about these kids), this hasn't stopped pre-teens from joining. According to a Consumer

"A strong educational base," the president says, is essential for a growing economy. 'Education is an investment," says the president. He talks about the state of the job market, and how unemployment among college graduates is less than among those who do not have a higher education. He discussed the jobs bill he proposed, which Congress has only just begun to pass and only partially. He listed things Congress should be doing in order to help the economy recuperate.

Henderson sports arena: proposed arena breaking new ground

The proposed Henderson arena is clearing hurdles and making strides to becoming a reality, but don't get too happy just yet because with developer Milam's past in proposing arenas, this one may get hung out to dry.

The proposed Henderson arena will be an enclosed 17,500 seat arena and will play host to events and possibly a professional basketball franchise.

Just recently, a \$650 million loan was approved by an investment committee (China Security and Surveillance Technology Inc.) Though plans and

details aren't final yet (a final agreement is still in the works), Chris Milam, the developer, is confident in saying that the deal is approved.

As of right now, the main plans are for an indoor



stadium for hosting events and a potential professional basketball team as well as an outdoor stadium for a professional soccer franchise, which will be built concurrently and will cost \$1.3 billion. In the week of

June 3, Chris Milam and his company cleared another hurdle when he added \$2.1 million to his bid for the land. The bid is for a plot of federal land near M Resort, south of the Las Vegas strip. However, things aren't

quite clear yet. Chris Milam has until December 3 to come up with the remainder of the \$10.5 million for the approximate 480 acres. A spokesman for Milam said that he hopes to break ground by December 31 and has already been in

talks with professional If all goes well for Milam as early as 2014.

Estate planning tips: Planning to protect your property and family

By Dorothy Bunce The Guardian Express If you have less than \$5,000,000 in assets, lucky you! When you die, your property will not have to pay any federal estate tax. Since Nevada has no state death taxes, your heirs won't have to pay taxes on anything they might receive due to your death. However,

if you are, like the rest of us, not a multimillionaire, it does not mean you shouldn't consider estate planning to protect your property and your family.

What is your estate? Most people think of their estate as their real estate. But with today's low real estate prices, many people no longer have any equity in the real estate they own. So if you were to die tomorrow, your estate would still include your real estate, but would also include assets not paid to a named beneficiary. It is very common for life insurance and retirement accounts to be paid to a person you have named on the account. If you haven't

named a person on your account, then this money is paid to your estate and would have to pass through probate before reaching the beneficiary you intended to receive it. Of course if you have investments or any other type of property, the title will either be in your name alone, in which case it does pass through probate, or it is held in joint names or with a named beneficiary. allowing it to be transferred without probate.

Avoiding probate isn't always a good thing.

For many years, the conventional wisdom has been to do everything you can to "avoid probate." But probate is not always the evil bogeyman that the people selling "self help kits" on avoiding probate have claimed. There are many financially sound reasons why an individual may not want to go "gung ho" on the avoiding probate bandwagon. In an attempt to avoid probate, it is possible that someone could lose everything they own and be kicked to the curb by not carefully con-

sidering the risks involved in holding title to property. Someone you love and trust today could become someone who could literally or figuratively put a knife in your back tomorrow.

Your young children.

If you die leaving young children, it may not matter how much or how little money you have. You know that your children will suffer should something happen to you. It is crucial that you develop an estate plan to provide for your children to minimize the awful impact of your death on them. Most important will be to have legal documents that state who you wish to provide them with a home and who is authorized to manage the children's money until they are old enough to manage it on their own. It is not necessary that the person that takes care of the children be the same person who manages the money for the children. In fact, it can be a good strategy to have these two roles filled by different people.

about how best to help parents keep their kids safe in an evolving online environment," Facebook said in a statement.

The announcement was made just weeks after Facebook's stock began trading publicly. The stock is down 31 percent from its initial public offering price of \$38, so allowing kids to legally join the site may help with revenue, since advertisers are constantly looking to target younger consumers.

But Ivet Santiago, executive director of Nevada Child Seekers, is more concerned that allowing these kids to access the social network can make them more vulnerable to predators and cyber bullying.

Both those events are looking increasingly likely as Assad continues to murder his own people and Iran continues its quest for nuclear weapons. The question remains: What will Obama eventually do? 5. James Harden, with his Abe Lincoln beard and powerful upper body, will be difficult for Battier to defend




